## CAM PREMIER LEAGUE (PART OF CAM YOUTH ASSOCIATION)

### Format, Rules, Terms, and Condition

---

1. CAM Premier League organized by CAM Youth Association will commence from 26th of March (Sunday) and will run around 15-18 weeks.
2. Each match will be played with a white ball In a T20 format. Grounds and umpires will be provided by the organizer.
3. Additional rules:
  - a. Teams are allowed to select 12 players in a game with any 11 can bat and bowl. If 13th or more player (max 3 substitutes allowed) is playing as a substitute/s (can only field), the name of those substitutes must be declared to the opposition captain and organiser prior to the start of match. If not declared, the team playing more than 12 players lose the match.
  - b. Two Non-Nepalese will be allowed in playing 11, whereas three non-Nepalese can be registered.
  - c. The winning team will get 4 points. For a tie or abandoned match, the points will split between the teams.
4. All the rules will be like ICC T20 Format.
5. Any ball bowl outside the pitch will be a no ball and all the no balls will be free hit.
6. The official start time for each match will be as schedules. Toss will be exactly 15 minutes before the match start time. Both team representative must be present for toss, if not the opponent will win the toss.
7. All 11 players will be required to start the match, Exception can be given for late arrival. The captain of those respective team should give pre notice to the organiser.
8. If any team with less than 11 players enters in the ground, then the team will be disqualified for the game and winning points will be given to the opponent team.
9. All the players should bring their physical CAM Premier League ID Card on their respective game day, without the ID Card, Players will not be registered on the Playing XI even if they are well known to the organiser (no excuses allowed)

10. If a team qualifies for the final match, they must submit their playing XI to the organizer one day before the match. If a team is unable to provide their playing XI, the team that finished in third place (based on net run rate throughout the tournament) will play the Final match.
11. All participants are expected to behave professionally and should avoid abusive language/gestures/ question umpires' decisions. The participants must also remember to treat other players with respect as well as have fun.
12. There is a severe penalty for anyone retorting to verbal or physical abuse. That player will attract a penalty, which may include expulsion from the ongoing tournament as well as permanent ban from the future Cricket League events for serious offences.
13. If three players from a single team are expelled for violent behaviour, the entire team will be banned. The team Captain must make sure that this does not happen.
14. Verbal abuse refers to language, actions, or behaviours that are abusive, hateful, or malicious in nature.
15. Captains are solely responsible for the conduct of the players. In case of a dispute only the team captain shall voice his concern to the umpires during or after the match. An umpire is a fellow playing member; please do not try to bully him. Captains will be representing the teams in case of a dispute on or off the field.
16. The Team Captain is responsible for informing all the teammates about when the team will be playing and on what dates. All the schedules will be updated on the Cricclub as well as on our Facebook page.
17. CAM Youth Association Team and the management committee will not be held accountable for any injuries happening during any of the games, loss or damage of any kind, financial loss, and loss of business, revenue, or goodwill. This will also be applicable for any adverse event that may take place outside the field before or after the matches, whereas minor first aid will be provided by the organiser during the game.
18. It is every team's responsibility to ensure that players have the correct equipment that is in good safe working order and take weather conditions into account when preparing to play match.
19. It is every team's responsibility that players are sufficiently fit and healthy to participate in the tournament. If there is any doubt, we recommend that you seek medical advice beforehand.
20. The tournament fee is non-refundable once the registration closed. All payments to be made via bank transfer.
21. The non-availability of players cannot be a reason to not play a match. In such a case, the opponent will be declared the winner and awarded full points.
22. Likewise, if a team pulls out of the match or the tournament for any reasons, its opposition/s will be declared the winner and awarded full points.

23. It is encouraged that despite issues on the field, the teams should complete their matches and raise issues to the organizers after the match. The organizers reserve the right to decide as required, including declaring the match null and arranging a rematch or deducting points of the teams.
24. All teams must agree that players name, image and contact details can be used by the Organizers for:
- a. Promotion and marketing of CAM Youth Association and CAM premier league.
  - b. Adding to a mailing list to keep them informed about the future tournaments.
25. In case of any discrepancy where the on-field umpires could not resolve a conflict, the organizer's decision is final and shall not be contested during this tournament. The organizers will update the rule book with respect to that situation during the setup of future tournaments.
26. The Organizers may cancel the event if circumstances arise beyond his reasonable control, especially under the current COVID circumstances. In such a case, we will Endeavor to communicate to the teams in advance. In the event of a cancellation, the organizers will have no responsibility for any costs incurred because of the cancellation. Any tournament fee left then will be refunded equally between the participating teams.
27. No trophy/cash prizes will be awarded if the tournament is cancelled due to unavoidable circumstances.
28. If the game is not played on scheduled date due to any circumstance (natural or technical errors) then the game will be rescheduled again after the scheduled games are played. In case, if the game cannot be played again on a rescheduled date, then the points will be divided between two teams. (This rule can be updated anytime by the organiser depending upon ongoing situation)
29. Agreement shall be governed by Australian law, and the parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Australian courts. If any provision of the agreement is invalid or unenforceable, in whole or in part, the validity of the remainder shall not be affected. The agreement does not create, confer or purport to confer any benefit or right enforceable by any person not a party to it.

**The Tournament format, rules, terms, and conditions are subject to changes. Giving consent means also agreeing to changes that will be made from time to time. The teams will be notified of changes when made.**
